Meeting called to order at 10:30 a.m. by chair Stu Walter
He led the Pledge of Allegiance
Motion to approve the agenda by Trudi P, seconded by Dean S, with the addition of f) and g) to Stu's report

Barb K read the secretary's report. Maggie T made a motion to approve the reading, seconded by Tracy W, with the addition of new business last month: Trudi P asked for input about the Badger State Sheriffs Association after she received a solicitation in the mail from Waupaca County Sheriff Tim Wilz. No one else had gotten the mailing, and no one had info. Motion carried.

Tracy had visuals of the treasurer's report with some changes due to donations and dues coming in. She also reported the electric bill will go down, and a new account is being established for monthly maintenance of \$500. Motion to approve by Trudi, seconded by Tom O motion carried.
Stu answered Dean's question from last month about a flat gas rate...it is only offered to residences. Dean also asked if the roof needed checking? Stu had checked it last fall, patched it. It is a rubber roof which probably needs to be redone.

Tracy gave a technology report: she and Henry worked on who does and doesn't have authority to do Instagram changes. She and Henry are now administrators. She has the instructions for this information on a Google drive. She will send the information to Maggie who will make a printout for the office. Tracy also updated the website with election results and has started a 2024 fall election page to be under construction.

Kudos to Trudi for "scooping" the April newsletter article on the food pantry at the Waupaca library. Her focus for May and the future will be on suppressing gun violence. She will also pursue further information on the letter she received from Sheriff Wilz and the WSSA.
