- D. Everyone please continue to contribute to the food pantries. Manawa has been the recipient the last few months. The ink cartridges brought in \$700 in the last year and a half, so please continue to bring those in.
- E. The events trailer is almost complete for the summer usage. Stu thanks everyone who has volunteered for helping.

New business:

2. Everyone needs to know more about the new Wisconsin districts for state Assembly and Senate. Keep posting maps and information.
